How to turn off nordictrack treadmill 1750

First, take a look at the PART IDENTIFICATION CHART on page 5 to identify small parts used for assembly. Use the drawings provided to locate each part and note its corresponding key number. Before starting the assembly process, make sure you have two people assisting you. Place all parts in a cleared area and remove the power cord from the treadmill. Next, attach the Belly Pan Wire (96) to the Upright Wire (120) in the Right Upright (114). Make sure the connectors snap into place with an audible click. With the help of your second person, hold the handrail assembly on the Left and Right Uprights. Attach the handrail assembly using four 3/8" x 2 3/4" Screws (2) and four 3/8"... Continue by attaching the Left Inner Grip (101) to the left side of the handrail assembly in the same way as the Right Inner Grip (102). Have your second person hold the console assembly near the handrail assembly. Connect the wires from the console assembly to the wires from the handrail assembly, making sure they snap into place with an audible click. Next, rotate the console assembly back to its original position and firmly tighten the two M6 x 25mm Screws (8) that you attached in step 10. Before proceeding further, ensure the treadmill is assembled on a smooth surface. If not, raise the Frame (74) to the vertical position shown. Remove the 5/16" Nut (49) and the 5/16" x 2 1/4" Bolt (27) from the bracket on the Latch Crossbar (76). Align the upper end of the Storage Latch (75) with the bracket and insert the 5/16" Screw. Now, plug in the power cord using the instructions provided on page 17. Set the incline to 10% by following the steps outlined on page 21. Finally, position the large cutout (S) in the Right Base Cover around the Right Upright (114), and slide the Right Base Cover downward onto the Base. Important: Always follow safety guidelines when assembling and using your COMMERCIAL 1750 treadmill. Given text here Suppressor devices, except for low-power devices such as cell phone chargers, can be connected directly to an outlet on the same circuit as other electronic equipment like your treadmill. The console features wireless technology that allows for instant exercise feedback and connects to iFIT for a rotating selection of featured workouts.
