Valley Health Urgent Care treats those everyday illnesses and injuries which require immediate attention but do not require a visit to the emergency room. This includes, but is not limited to, colds, flu, strep, pink eye, sprains and strains. Valley Health Urgent Care also offers immunizations, school and sports physicals, on-site x-ray and lab services. Valley Health Urgent Care is not meant to take the place of a patient's primary care physician. Patients will be referred back to their primary care provider for ongoing care. For patients who do not have a primary care provider, Valley Health Urgent Care is happy to refer them to a primary care provider currently accepting new patients. Valley Health Urgent Care treats young children through senior citizens. Valley Health Urgent Care does not treat infants less than 4 months of age. Valley Health Urgent Care's highly trained team includes physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners to care for patients. These expert, caring professionals will see that you receive the appropriate treatment. For patients with non-emergent health conditions, Valley Health Urgent Care is typically less expensive and quicker than a visit to a hospital emergency department. For many patients with insurance the cost of an urgent care visit is the same as a physician office visit. Payment is expected at the time of your visit. For patients with insurance this is the co-pay as specified by your insurance plan. An initial co-pay of \$150 is required from patients not having insurance. Patients will be billed for the remaining balance. Valley Health Urgent Care accepts cash, personal checks, Visa and MasterCard. Valley Health Urgent Care participates with many insurance plans. Your specific insurance plan determines whether your co-pay is the same as a physician office visit or if there is a different co-pay amount. Please consult your insurance prior to your visit to determine your coverage. Also, if you would like us to bill your insurance, please remember to bring your insurance card and personal identification. We offer flu and travel immunizations for our patients. Virtual visits are a self-pay service, which means insurance is not accepted. Each virtual visit will be a \$59 fee. Insurance is still accepted for in-person visits at all of our Valley Health Urgent Care locations. Can I have a virtual visit with Valley Health Urgent Care if I have never visited a location in-person? Yes, you can schedule a virtual visit even if you're a new patient. What symptoms can be treated by a virtual visit? Providers will be able to assess, diagnose, treat, and prescribe virtually for these conditions: Skin Rashes and Bug Bites Poison Ivy Pink Eye and Eye Infections Cold Symptoms Scratchy or Sore throat Congestion Nausea Fever Headaches and more Yes, your provider will evaluate, diagnose and treat your symptoms during your virtual visit and the provider will send any prescribed medications to your pharmacy of choice. Why am I being asked to fill out health information during the check-out process? Valley Health providers need to have basic information about your health in order to provide you with the highest quality care possible. Will notes from my virtual visit appear in MyChart? Yes, your notes and visit summary will appear in your Valley Health MyChart account. The amount each patient pays personally out of pocket (OOP) is determined by their health insurance plan's benefit option selected at the time of enrollment as well as any previously paid services that may impact the currently outstanding deductible or other OOP limitations.
